

Quick Start Guide for EagleEye App

This document briefly describes how to install and manage the EagleEye app on your Android[™] tablet.

Introduction to EagleEye app

InterferenceAdvisor[™] EagleEye[™] is Viavi Solutions' Android application that has been designed for interference hunting. It displays received signal level, frequency, and suspected interference area on Google Maps. Its easy-to-use features make interference hunting activities quick and easy.

Setting up your tablet

After you have turned up your tablet and completed the initial set-up, you need to set up the required settings for the EagleEye app.

To activate the developer mode

- 1 On the Home screen, go to **Apps > Settings > System > About device**.
- Scroll to and tap Build number seven times.
 The Developer options menu appears under Settings > System > Developer options.

To enable the allow mock location

- **1** Go to **Apps > Settings > Developer options**.
- **2** Scroll to **Allow mock locations**, and then check the checkbox to enable. When enabled, a check mark appears in the tick box.

To connect to a Wi-Fi connection

- 1 On the Home screen, go to **Apps > Settings > Wi-Fi**.
- **2** Tap the switch to activate the Wi-Fi feature. After searching nearby network, the tablet displays a list of networks.
- **3** Select a network from the networks list.
- 4 Tap CONNECT.

Installing the application

The EagleEye app requires a registered Google account and Google Play services 9.0 or higher version.





To add a Google account

- **1** From a Home screen, go to **Apps > Settings > Accounts**.
- 2 Select Add account > Google.
- **3** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the account setup.

NOTE You can also set up your Google account or create a new Google account when you turn on your tablet for the first time or after performing the data reset.

To check the version of Google Play services

- 1 From the Home screen, go to **Apps > Play Store**.
- 2 Tap (≡) on the search field or drag the screen edge from left to right, and then select **Settings**.
- **3** Scroll to **Build version** and then check the current version of Google Play services. To download and install the latest version of Google Play services, touch **Build version**.

To download and install the EalgleEye app

- **1** On your tablet, open the **Internet** app.
- **2** Go to <u>http://celladvisor.updatemyunit.net/</u>, and then download the apk file for the EagleEye app.

The downloaded file will be stored in your tablet's storage.

- **3** On the Home screen, go to **Apps > My Files > Download**.
- 4 Tap the **EagleEye.x.x.apk** file and then tap **INSTALL**. Once installed, the EagleEye app appears on the Apps screen.
